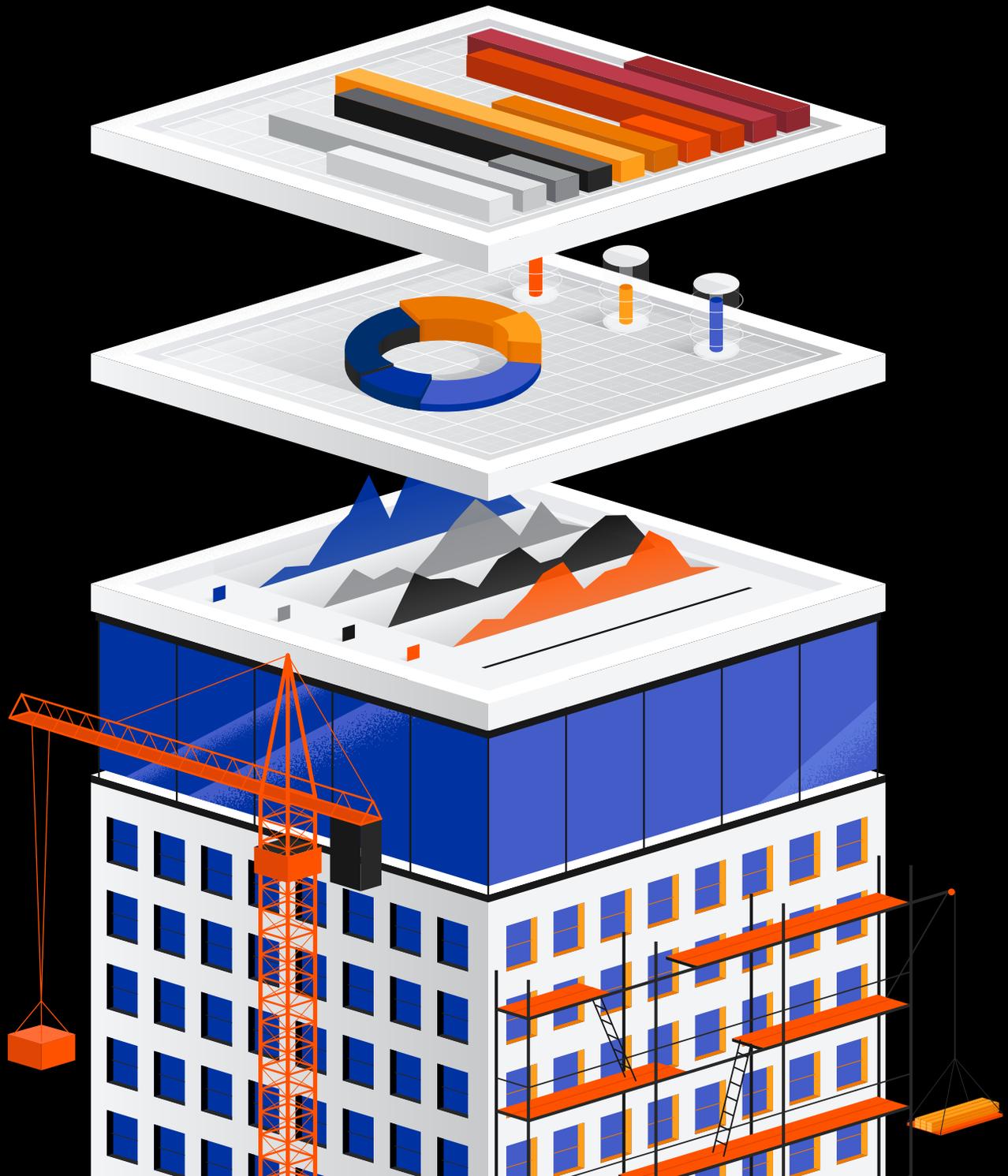

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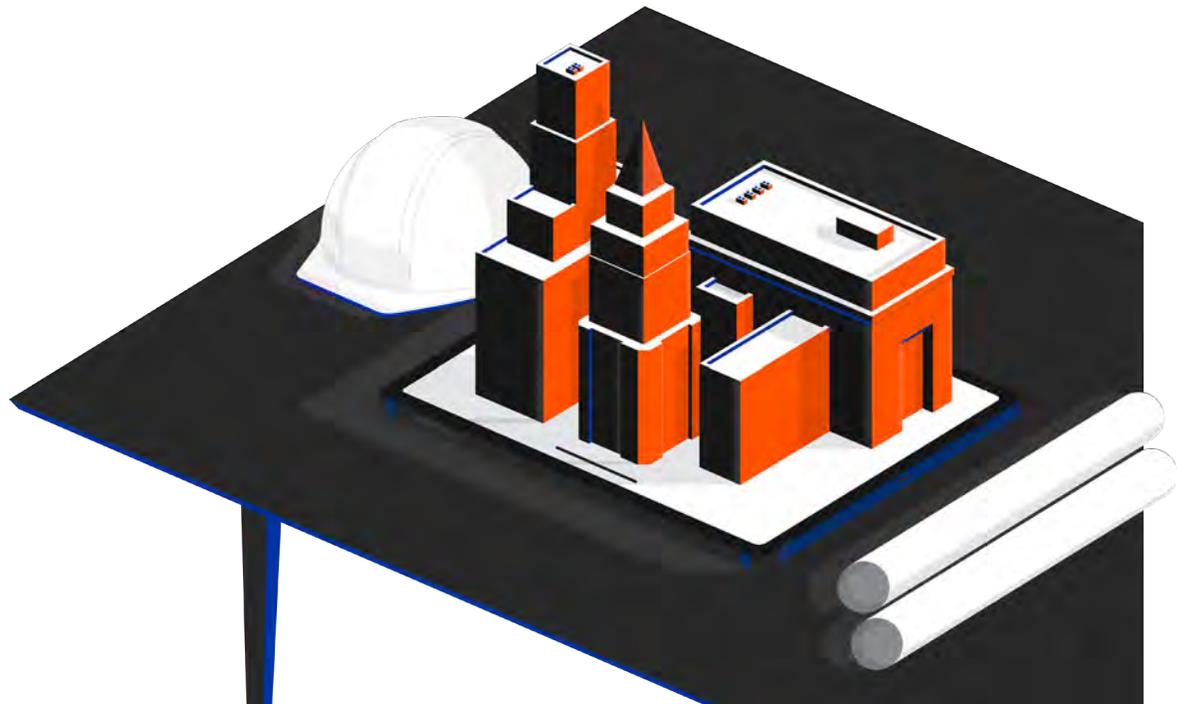
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# Introducing the next era of construction.

## Global Survey Participants

We surveyed **4,784** Procore customers from around the globe—including North, Central and South America, Asia, Europe, Australia and the Middle East. The data includes responses from head contractors, subcontractors and owners/developers from companies and public entities of all sizes. All survey responses are self-reported and, unless otherwise noted, all references to customers, users or any individual stakeholder group mentioned herein refer to the population surveyed.

## How you can use this report.

Throughout the survey, respondents kept using one word over and over: communication. In fact, it was mentioned 548 times—showing a unanimous emphasis on remaining connected in a year of mandated distancing. Terms like “**standardised processes**”, “**accurate forecasting**”, “**improved communication**” and “**exceeding profit goals**” seem like luxuries in a year focused on survival. And yet, these numbers are staggering:

reported more **accurate forecasting**

**The findings correspond with those reported by consulting firms like McKinsey. According to McKinsey, the first “action for success” in response to the Coronavirus’s impact is to “accelerate rollout and adoption of digitisation. There is no time to experiment with the perfect road map”. Action is indispensable.** This report should function as a guide for areas of improvement, identify where other companies are saving time and money, where they are reducing risk and utilising digital tools to similar effect.

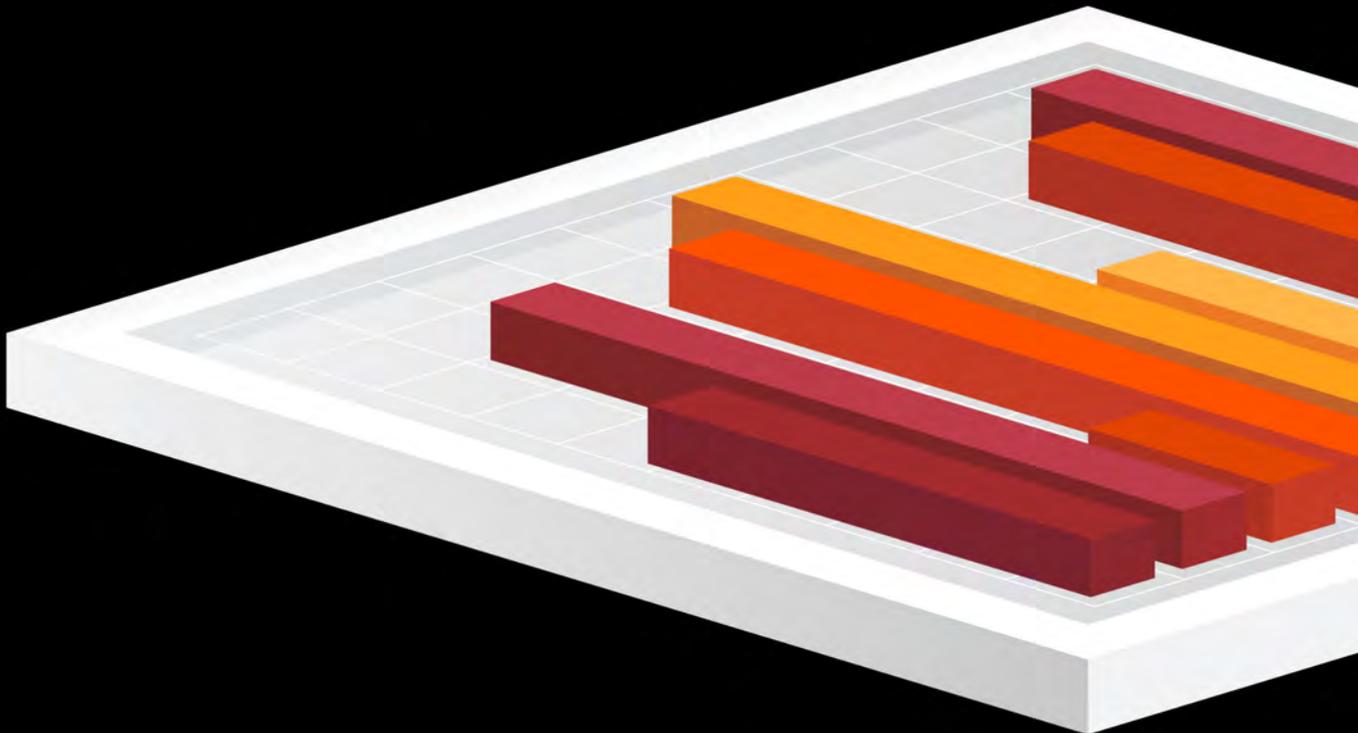

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# A Changed World— Rethinking Communication

For everyone in construction, communication is the linchpin that holds projects together. As FMI put it, “Optimising digital technology... is probably just what the construction industry needed. 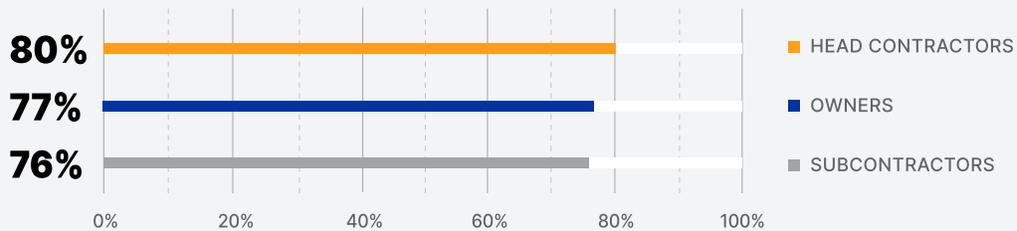

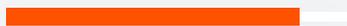

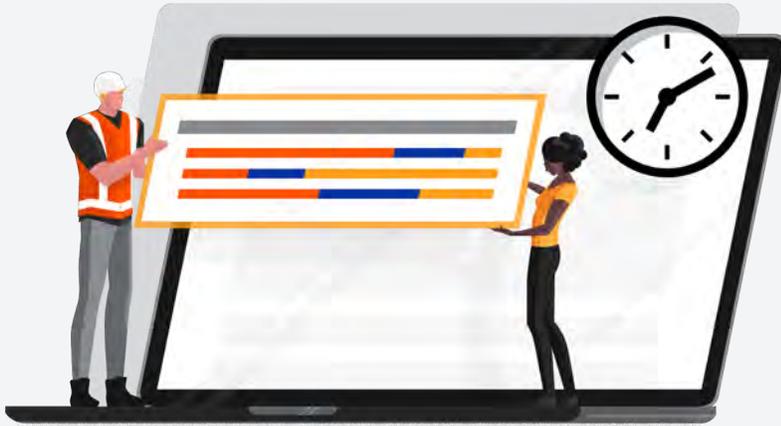

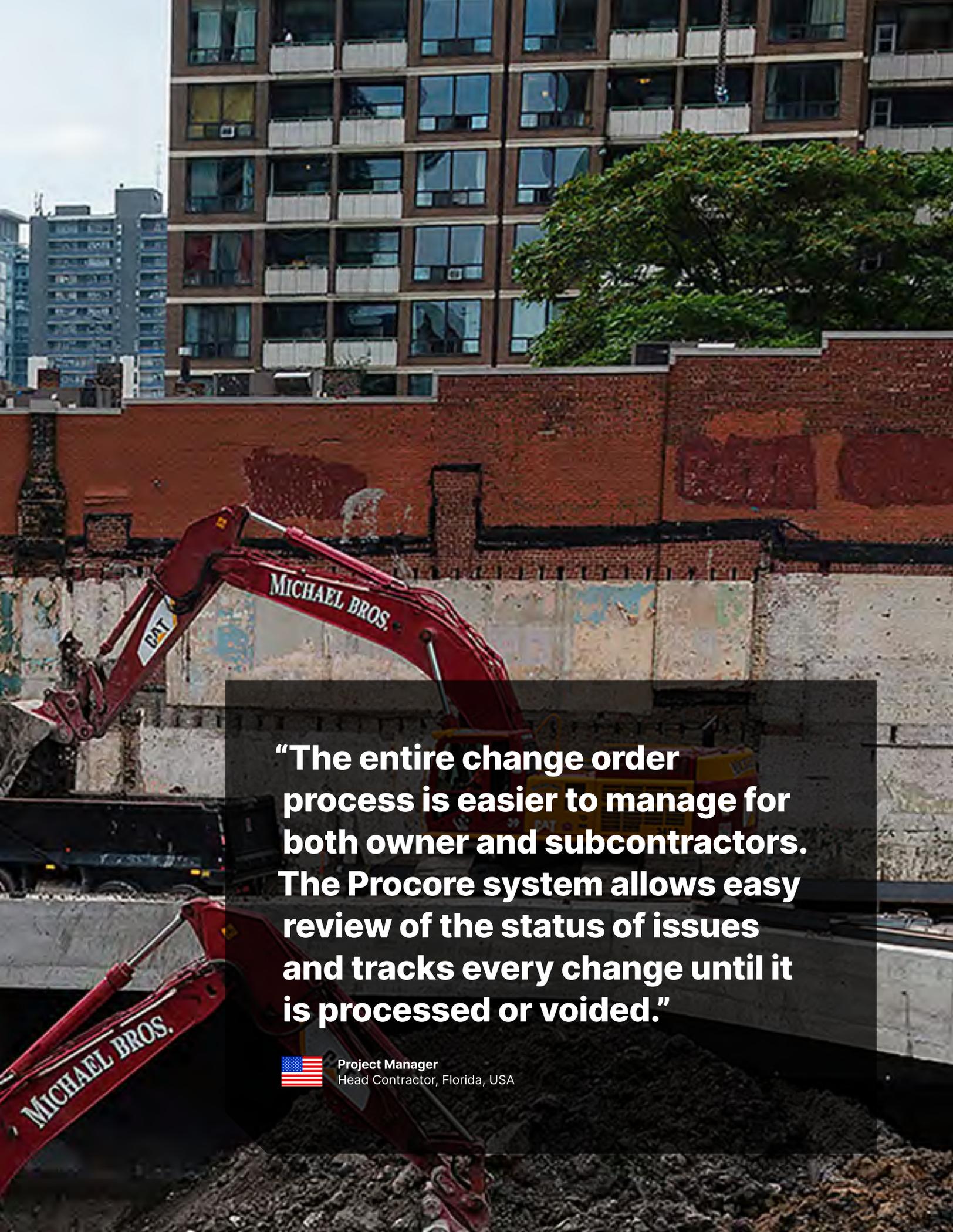

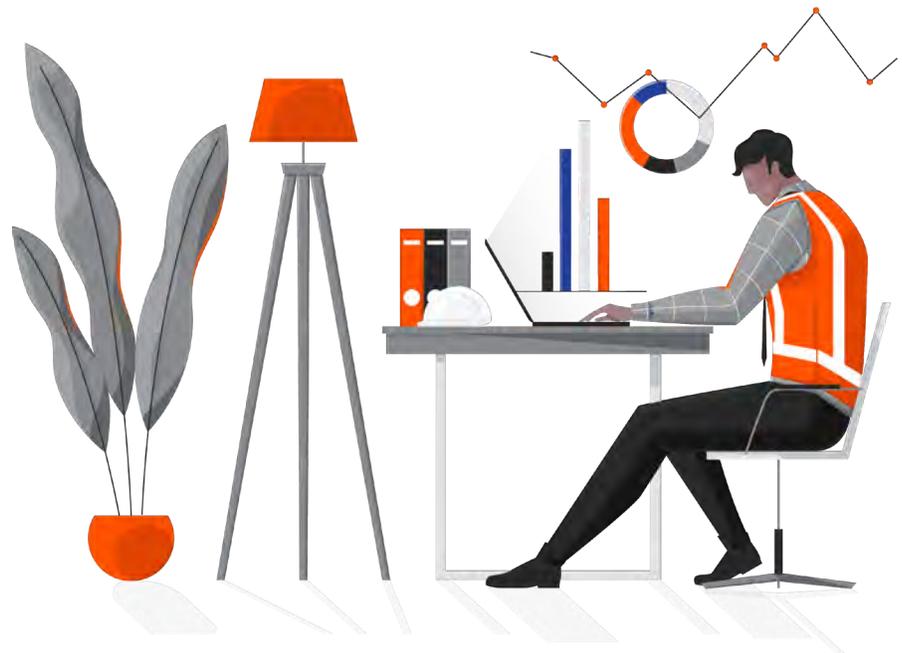


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## Improving Profits

Construction has always been an industry with thin margins. In a year plagued by uncertainty, accurate forecasting and reliable financial processes were especially vital. According to Construction Dive, the cost of construction materials is rising on a monthly basis, with a 0.8% in May, followed by a 2.3% rise in June of 2020. McKinsey highlights supply chain interruptions and a decrease in

demand for new construction as additional hurdles for the industry. It goes on to suggest that economic activity in construction might not return to 2019 levels until 2023. With these new challenges, protecting margins has become more important than ever. Here's how businesses are finding ways to shore up their bottom lines.
